#### **General Comments:**

By the late 1920's, surfmen were no longer assigned a number as their rank with the exception of Surfman No. 1, who was the next person in charge after the keeper. By the start of WWII, most of the younger surfmen had been taken away from their stations and re-assigned to landing craft coxswain duties. They were replaced by less well trained non-rated crew such as a Seaman or Seaman's Apprentice.

During WWI and Prohibition, station crew complements were typically increased to allow for increased patrols both shoreside and on boats. During Prohibition, many stations (including Portsmouth Harbor) were assigned higher-speed cabin picket boats for patrol and interception of incoming rum-running speedboats, which required additional crews from the stations to which they were assigned. At the end of Prohibition and the beginning of the Great Depression, most station crews were reduced in number as a cost-saving measure.

#### Details from Logbook Entries:

- -The Jerry's Point station was provided with a new launchway ramp in May 1899.
- -The Wood Island station initially did not have a wreck pole when the station was placed in operation in 1908. The pole was added over the next year or so of operation so that they could perform the breeches buoy drill.
- -The life car assigned to Jerry's Point was transferred over to Wood Island, and was still being used in drills as late as the early 1930's long after being abandoned by other stations.
- -The 28ft. long Excelsior type pulling surfboat No. 781, received brand new by Jerry's Point/Wood Island in 1907, lasted in service well into 1933, long after other surfboats of this type had been decommissioned. Logbook entries indicate that exceptional care was given to this particular boat by the station crew.
- -The first Beebe-McLellan type motor surfboat assigned to Wood Island (received on 25 JAN 1910) was destroyed in a 1914 storm, after which the station received a replacement, No. 1217 on 25 JAN 1915 by means of the Boston & Maine Railroad. The original Aristox horizontal gasoline engine in No. 1217 was later replaced by a vertical type Kermath gasoline engine in May 1925. By 1927, this motor surfboat was no longer in service and replaced by Type H motor surfboats Nos. 1859 (received in NOV 1923) and 3050 (received in OCT 1927, transferred from Station Narragansett Pier in RI).
- -Station Portsmouth Harbor (Wood Island) received its first cabin picket boat for Prohibition patrols, a 36ft. long single cabin picket boat No. 2226, in June of 1928; it was used over the 1928 to 1931 period, after which it was replaced by a later model 38ft. cabin picket boat, No. 2385/CG38301, in June 1931. This boat was then replaced by 1937 by an older model 36ft. double cabin picket boat No. 2371/CG36306.
- -Station Portsmouth Harbor (Wood Island) received its first motor lifeboat, a 36ft. Type H No. 1854, in JAN 1935, being transferred from its original station Isle of Shoals.
